Artworks has an extensive alarm system and video cameras are installed in multiple locations including both galleries. Artworks does carry liability insurance however, participants assume all risks and provide their own insurance. Artworks is NOT sprinklered.
<b>Marketing:</b> Poster design and printing of posters will be handled by Artworks. Postcards may also be available as an invitation for the exhibit and reception. Print, radio and social media will also be used to market this exhibit.
